1. Google XML Sitemaps

A common SEO task is to consistently update Google using a XML sitemap of the newest content you have written. This plugin for Wordpress automatically generates for you an updated Google XML compliant sitemap everytime you publish a new blog post.

2. All in One SEO Pack
