WordPress - The Most Popular Blogging CMS

beginners use WordPress because it has a very simple and intuitive user interface. With few simple steps you can create your first website. Even if you have never worked with any of similar web systems you will be able to create web pages from scratch. One of the reasons is the WYSIWYG editor which is similar to Word or other popular text editors. This means that you need no HTML/CSS knowledge to create a website.

WordPress supports template system which enables you to define page layout simply by selecting one of many themes. WordPress theme is a collection of files which define how the page will look like, where menus will be located, text styles, header graphics, etc. There are many WordPress themes available all around the web--you only need to know what kind of website you would like to have, whether there should be a column on the left or on the right side, what type of menu, etc. Theme is what makes your website unique. With right theme and few customizations you can make the website according to your needs and taste.

In addition to the huge number of various themes there is also a plethora of plugins which can add additional functionality to the WordPress website. There is at least one plugin for every possible web service or functionality you can imagine. Plugins can completely change the basic WordPress behavior.

An additional advantage of WordPress is that you can search for themes and plugins directly in the backend administration interface. Once you have found a nice template or desired plugin you can install it with only few clicks. This is very convenient for beginners which might have troubles finding and installing external extension files.

Like most similar content management systems WordPress uses MySQL database to store data. However, creating a database is very simple and there are many tutorials on the web that clearly describe all the required steps. Once the WordPress is set up and installed you can immediately start creating pages. Of course, in many cases the first step after the installation will be to design the header logo which will give the "face" to the website.

An example of a project powered by Wordpress is the [Financial Advices](#) website. Without looking at the page source you can not tell which system is used to power the website. Of course, visitors usually don't care about the system, they only need good content--in this case [financial advices](#).
